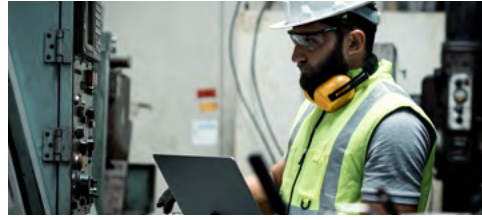

YOUR COMMITMENT

- Identify an energy management team of two or more professionals for the program, and designate an energy champion to lead the team
- Identify an executive sponsor
- Participate regularly in cohort activities
- Complete an energy management assessment or an "ISO 50001 Ready" assessment
- Establish energy goals and targets and maintain a project registry

ELIGIBILITY

To qualify for the program, your organization must:

- Own or operate an industrial, commercial or institutional facility/facilities in Ontario
- Have a minimum consumption of 3,000,000 kWh in one year
